

EMERGENCY FUNCTIONS

In any emergency, it is essential for all responders to coordinate efforts and work together as a team.

Emergency responders or those with responsibility for emergency functions at district facilities may include *all employees*, but those with key responsibility for emergency response and/or management include:

- Site Administrators and Managers
- District Police personnel
- Safety Monitors
- Community Emergency Response Team Members
- Buildings and Grounds personnel
- Employees with special skills and/or training (Nursing instructors, athletic trainers, child care center staff, etc.)
- Other faculty and staff members as assigned
- Volunteers

Emergency functions typically include, but are not limited to:

- Alert/Warning
- Communications
- Construction and Engineering
- Care and Shelter
- Damage Assessment
- Debris Removal
- Emergency Management
- Evacuation
- External Affairs
- Firefighting
- Hazardous Materials Management
- Law Enforcement
- Medical Services
- Morgue Operations
- Public and Environmental Health
- Resource Management
- Search and Rescue
- Traffic Control
- Transportation
- Utilities Management
