

ASSOCIATED STUDENTS ELECTIONS

1. The Associated Students shall conduct annual elections to elect officers based on College election procedures, which are available through the Student Activities Offices or Student Life Center.
2. Any student elected as an officer in the Associated Students shall meet the following requirements:
 - The student shall be enrolled in the District at the time of election and throughout his or her term of office, with a minimum of five semester units or the equivalent.
 - The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship, as defined in Board Policy 4001 and Curriculum and Instruction Procedure 4001.
 - The student shall remain in good academic and disciplinary standing as defined in the student code of conduct throughout the duration of their term.
3. Failure to maintain minimum requirements bulleted above, throughout the term of office, will result in immediate loss of office.
