This project is a public works project and is subject to prevailing wage rate laws. A copy of the prevailing rates of wages is on file with the Contracts & Purchasing Office of the Contra Costa Community College District. Said rates of wages will be included in the contract for the work. Attention is directed to Section 4100 through 5113 of the Government Code concerning subcontractors. Liquidated Damages shall be set for Six Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00) for each calendar day the work is delayed. The Governing Board of the Contra Costa Community College District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any informality or irregularity in any bid received. No bidder may withdraw their Bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for opening thereof.
