SCOPE OF WORK

Scope of Project Inspector Services

Provide all labor, tools, equipment and supervision to perform PROJECT INSPECTOR Services, as required by DSA. Services shall be provided at the direction of the District and Architect. All inspection reports including Daily Inspection Logs, written report, etc. shall be submitted to the Project Manager, with copies to the District. Additional reports may be required to be submitted to the Architect and its consulting engineers as requested by the District. Reports must be signed by the designated PROJECT INSPECTOR and verified onsite by the on-site Project Manager. Individuals will be required to use Expedition document control software in preparing and submitting some or all of the inspection reports. On-site access to Expedition will be provided by the District. The types of Inspection Services to be provided include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Concrete Batch Plant
- Precast Plant
- Pipe Fabrication
- Fill & Gravel
- Asphalt
